The Elements of a Story

Knowing story elements is helpful to readers and writers.

Good writers use these elements in their work!



Here are some important story elements you should know:

Characters: The characters are the people, animals or things the story is about.

Setting: The setting is the time and place in which the story happened.

Plot: The plot is the events or things that happen in the story.

Conflict: The conflict is what the main character goes through (the problem or the struggle).

Message: The message is the life lesson or idea learned from the story.

The Plot:
