

2020 MOLIN SUMMER READING ASSIGNMENT: GRADE 5



How do you choose books to read? Do you spend a long time looking for a book? There are so many ways to select a book!



One way is a book recommendation. When someone recommends a book they usually give reasons why they liked it. They may briefly describe some events that took place, the setting and/or some of the characters, but they don't give away the ending!

Now, it's your turn! Help us add to the 5th grade collection of book recommendations by completing the following steps:

- Choose one free choice book that you enjoyed this summer. Fill out the
 recommendation on the next page with your name, the title, author's name, and
 the genre of the book.
- Write your summary: Without giving the whole story or the ending away, write about what happens in the book. Write a minimum of 5 sentences, and use specific details and describing words. Refer back to the book if you need to!
- Write your opinion: Tell us why you liked the book. Explain your reasoning by supporting your opinion with examples from the text. Your job is to convince others that this book is worth reading.
- Write your **reflection**: Choose 3 of the following sentence starters and write at least 2 complete, detailed sentences responding to each.
 - I think... I wonder... I know... I admire... I was surprised... I was impressed... I felt...
 I was concerned... I noticed that... I made a connection to... I identified with... I
 learned....
